

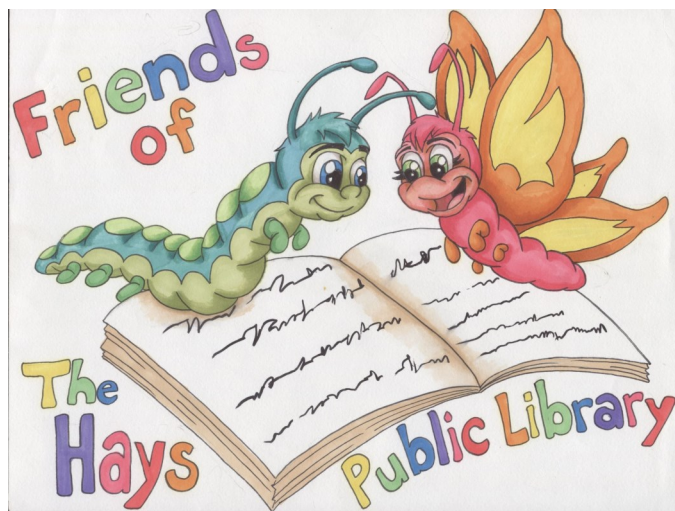
# Friends Yearly Book Mark Newsletter September 2016

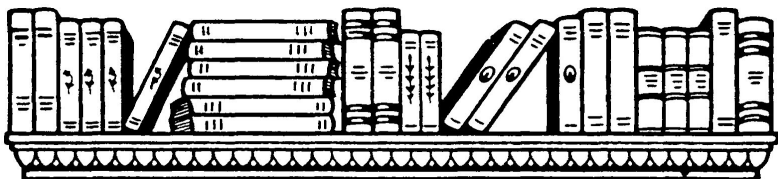

There are many ways to help out Friends of the Hays Public Library! We are always excited to hear new ideas and use the many talents of our members & volunteers.

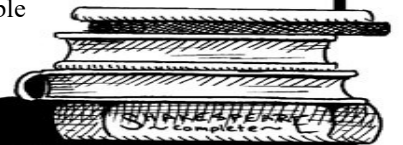
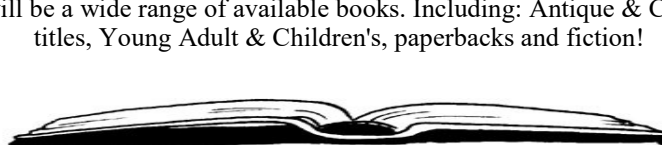
