Thank you for your membership and your support of the Friends of the Hays Public Library. We appreciate our members, volunteers, and donors. We are also grateful for everyone who attends our book sales or visits our store.

2019 was a good year to be involved with Friends activities at the library. There was much to accomplish as we received many donated books from the HPL and from the community and needed to move into a different storage area. We conducted 2 large bag sales and several flash sales in addition to running the bookstore.

We've turned our book sales earnings into funds to help the Library Foundation purchase items for the bookmobile and to help defray the cost of printing of this year's Chilly the Penguin book. We've helped fund YA and Children's department projects, maintained the Free Books shelf in the library, donated children's books during the summer meal program, and provided massages for the library staff to help celebrate National Library Week. We have gained as individuals from the work we do supporting the Friends group.

As a thank you, this year we've added a Friends "logo" bag as a benefit of membership. These bags can be filled with materials from the Gallery sale for a set price at each bag sale.

Members also receive a 10% discount on any items purchased during regular bookstore hours and usually a 50% discount on bookstore items during bag or flash sales.

Except for January, when our Executive Board meeting is just prior to the Annual Meeting, our board meetings are held on the second Monday of the month at 3:30 p.m. in the Gallery. All members are welcome to attend.


