Use Beanstack to log reading time and other completed activities for chances to win prizes. Library staff will assist with sign-up and logging for those without computer access.

The Summer Challenge is for all ages with a variety of age-appropriate activities planned throughout the challenge. For ages 0-5, caregivers log the amount of time they read to the child and other early literacy activities they complete. Elementary age and teens will log their reading time and complete other activities.



Adults participate by completing 10 activities. The list can be picked up at the library beginning May 20. Completed lists turned in by July 31 will be entered into the end of summer prize drawing.

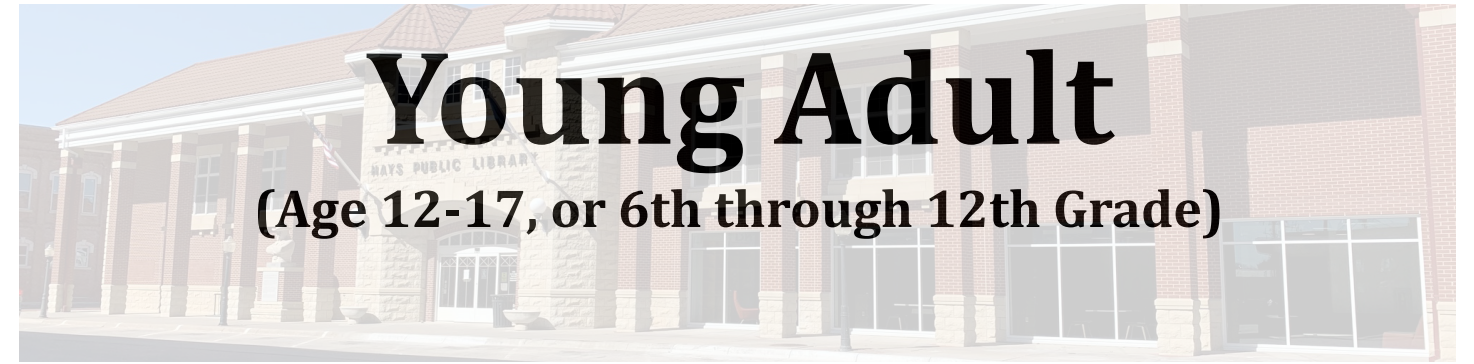
